

# IMPORTANT USE & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE READ PRIOR TO PLACING OVENLINER IN OVEN

**FOR ELECTRIC OVENS WITH A VISIBLE HEATING ELEMENT ON THE FLOOR OF THE OVEN:** Place Ovenliner on the bottom of the oven, under the element.

**FOR ELECTRIC OVENS WITH NO VISIBLE HEATING ELEMENT ON THE FLOOR OF THE OVEN:** Place Ovenliner on the bottom wire rack (not on the floor of the oven).\* You may place baking dishes and pans directly on the Ovenliner's surface.

**FOR GAS OVENS:** Place Ovenliner on the bottom wire rack (not on the floor of the oven).\* Do not cover or block any holes inside the oven. You may place baking dishes and pans directly on the Ovenliner's surface.

Ovenliners are safe to use in convection ovens. For proper placement, refer to the above instructions.

\* *To ensure optimum heat circulation, trim the Ovenliner with household scissors to fit the wire rack. The Ovenliner should not extend over the edges of the wire rack.*

## CAUTION:

- Failure to use the Ovenliner as directed could damage your oven
- Do not use directly on oven element or open flame
- Do not use above 550° F (287° C)
- Remove Ovenliner before using the oven's self-cleaning mode
- Clean the Ovenliner regularly, do not allow grease to build up
- Do not cover or block any holes in the oven—covering holes could create unsafe carbon monoxide levels

Chef's Planet Ovenliners are dishwasher safe or can be washed in warm, soapy water. Wipe dry with a soft cloth. To preserve the nonstick qualities do not use abrasive cleaners, sharp implements or fold the Ovenliner.

Chef's Planet Ovenliners will withstand extreme temperatures up to 550° F (287° C). After use, some discoloration may occur but will not affect performance.
